ITINERARY



Day 1: ShangHai Arrival (On your own ticket/Flight to be advised)

Fly to Shanghai for a three night stay.

Meals: None

Accommodations: Greenland Jiulong Hotel/Deluxe

Day 2: ShangHai – ZhuJiaJiao

Travel to Zhujiajiao, a picturesque town with an intricate system of canals, ancient pavilions and overhead bridges, including Fangsheng Bridge. Meet the friendly locals and explore the town at a leisurely walking pace. Return to Shanghai and visit the Shanghai Museum. Dinner this evening will be a banquet of traditional Shanghai cuisine.

Day 3: ShangHai

Enjoy a full-day tour to explore this cosmopolitan city. Visit the traditional Yu Gardens, the Old Town, a Silk Museum and the Xintiandi area, with its 1920s-style 'shikumen' buildings that are unique to Shanghai. Stroll along the famous Bund and explore Nanjing Road. This evening enjoy a cruise along the Huangpu River.

Day 4: ShangHai - Xian

Fly to Xian, the former imperial capital. This evening feast on a traditional Shui Jiao Dumpling banquet, a specialty of the region, while enjoying a performance of music and dance dating back to the Tang Dynasty.

Day 5: Xian

Explore one of the most significant archaeological discoveries of the 20th century, the UNESCO World Heritage listed Terracotta Warriors and Horses. Later, visit the Xian Art Ceramics and Lacquer Exhibition and walk along the ancient City Wall.

Day 6: Xian - Beijing

Visit the Little Wild Goose Pagoda before strolling through the Muslim Quarter and exploring the lively Islamic food markets. Later, fly to Beijing.

Day 7: Beijing

Stroll through Tiananmen Square, passing Chairman Mao's Mausoleum. Visit the treasure-filled Forbidden City, the world's largest palace complex and home to the Ming and Qing dynasties for over 500 years. Next, visit the unique 15th-century Temple of Heaven, one of the most perfect examples of Ming architecture, which has four gates, one at each of the four points of the compass. The local people that gather here to sing folk songs, practise Tai-Chi and sword dancing, play chess or gossip will be the highlight of your visit. This evening watch an exciting acrobatics performance.

Day 8: Beijing

It is often said in Beijing that 'you have not been to China until you have climbed the Great Wall'. It is more than 5,000km long, stretching from the Shanhaiguan Pass on the east coast to the Gobi Desert in the west. Walk along the wall, admire the panoramic views and reflect on the immensity of the material and labour required for its construction. It is estimated that one million people were used during the construction period. This afternoon, visit a jade factory and wander through the picturesque Summer Palace, admiring the landscaped beauty. It was once a royal garden and summer retreat for the members of the emperor's family and their courtesans. This evening sample the delicious local delicacy, Peking Duck, as your farewell dinner.
